Important communication | Adjusted Level 3 regulations

Dear Member

We hope this communication finds you and your family, safe and well.

Following the Presidents address on Monday evening, 28 December 2020, the Club's operating hours have changed with immediate effect due to the new curfew and specific restrictions reinstated. This includes the sale/consumption of alcohol being prohibited.

Following the publication of the "adjusted alert level 3 regulations" on 29 December 2020 please find attached communication from Golf RSA, including the updated safety poster: Physical distancing and wearing of face masks (v6, updated 29 December 2020). Revised operating hours:

Clubhouse opening 7h00

Clubhouse closing 20h00

Golf Operations

Both East & West golf courses remain open and will operate on a two tee start with 10 minute intervals.

Morning Fields: 8h00 – 9h40

Afternoon Fields: 12h30 – 13h10

Driving Range: 7h15 – 17h00

Lockerrooms - Shower facilities remain closed.

All bunker rakes and furniture have again been removed from the golf courses.

Note: New Years Eve – Club Closes at 15h00 (morning fields only).

New Years Day – Club Closed.

Food & Beverage

The patio, bar, halfway house & deck will operate as per 'normal' without any alcohol sales/consumption. The department will be financially affected by the alcohol ban and we appeal to all members to please support the departments takeaway and meal delivery service in the hope of supplementing some of the loss in revenue.



Management continue to handle the situation with urgency and extreme care. We regard the safety and well-being of our members, guests & staff of the utmost importance. Every action and measure taken by the board and management is done in the best interest of the club, its members and staff, is appropriate and remains in-line with all prescripts. We continue to ask that should you have a fever or flu-like symptoms or have travelled internationally or between provinces in recent weeks, to please refrain from visiting the club. Please continue exercising all responsible and safe hygiene practices.

We all have a role in helping prevent the spread of the virus. We must be aware and take responsibility at all times. Please be cognisant and apply face masks, social distancing and hand sanitizer at all times.

In closing, we would also like to advise members of a storm which also took place on Monday night, 28 December 2020. The storm produced 65mm of rain in a very short period of time and has left many bunkers and points along the waterway of the East course damaged. We are working with our insurer and intermediate repairs have started until suppliers and contractors return on 11 January 2021.
