### FROM THE CLOCK TOWER

Chris Bentley, Chief Executive Officer

Wow! Cameron Smith put together one of the great rounds in major history to become the Champion Golfer of the Year at the 150th Open Championship. Smith is also the first Aussie to win since Greg Norman in '93 and in the process shot the lowest fourth round score by a champion in St Andrews history, surpassing Zach Johnson's 66 in 2015. For me the par save on 17, with that ice-cold putt from 10 feet, was just sensational!

At the time of writing this month's column, the July Board meeting has just concluded and the mission to deliver, invest, protect, grow and evolve the Club, remains unchanged. "It's obligatory to keep focus on creating more benchmarks and, importantly, member retention. Investing in lifestyle and family centric facilities is about growth and future generations." Management have completed the preparations for the annual financial audit, taking place on 2 August 2022. The preliminary results reflect a break-even financial year (pre audit) which we are proud of considering the plethora of challenges which includes the exceptionally high levels of rainfall last summer (1285ml, over 7 months of the year, in comparison to 701ml in the prior year). This had a massive impact on rounds of golf, which in turn, impacted hospitality and ancillary sales. The weather alone represented a minimum loss of 6300 rounds and a total loss in revenue of R3m across the Club.

In terms of energy sustainability in these times of extreme load shedding, the Club has taken a very proactive approach. The irrigation system and pump stations are now 'off the grid', which eliminates the greatest risk of not being able to water our greens on hot summer days. The installation of additional generators has been completed, albeit the excessive fuel costs. The extreme power surges have also forced the Club to purchase additional 'UPS' systems to protect our equipment from failing. Moving forward, we have re-evaluated energy requirements and the various models and now look to secure a long-term solar solution to power the workshop and clubhouse. We are awaiting proposals for car port solutions, on a no capital basis, with the owner of the equipment becoming the new supplier of energy (SLA) with much lower tariffs than Eskom. The timing of solar also plays a key role as the Club plans its' course machinery replacement, with electric & hybrid units wherever possible. The full fleet of equipment is planned to be replaced in July 2023 and due to severe delays in production and shipping we are forced to place the order A.S.A.P.

Following the subscription renewals and static movement, the total membership current stands at 1 407. We are gearing to welcome the first 200 homeowners in each development in November this year, when they will take occupation of their units. With the Club's new facilities and inclusion of residential members, we forecast/plan for membership to grow to over 2 000 in the next year.





As a Club, we have been fortunate to overcome the various difficulties beyond control. In this regard, we thank you, the members, sincerely for all your support and loyalty throughout the financial year. We remain proud and inspired by the way our Club consistently rises to all the challenges – with flexibility, resilience, courage and caring hearts. We will continue to navigate the difficulties of our country, with maximum strategic clarity.

The Board and management now progress with the preparations for the 131st Annual General Meeting, set to take place on Wednesday, 21 September. In closing, our thoughts are with Greg Jacobs as he recovers from undergoing his bone marrow transplant on July 27. Greg will be in isolation for 100 days following the transplant and we continue to send positive thoughts, prayers and wishes to him and his family.









### THE GOLF DEPARTMENT

Liam Brown, RGA Director of Golf

The Championship East course remains in high demand through the renovation of West. We remind all members of the current booking policies in place especially for the weekend golfers. The policy for both Saturday and Sunday mornings are members only. The Saturday morning bookings remain the same at 8 days prior to and Sundays are 14 days in advance. Please note that with the large number of members and their member filled schools we are unable to fulfil special requests.

On arrival at the Club for your round of golf, the following is expected of all members and their guests:

- Arrive at your designated tee with your slip for the game,
   10 minutes prior to your time.
- Your nine-hole time including halfway is 2 hours and 15 minutes. If you fall behind the expected time you will be asked to grab and go or even forego this privilege.

Your 18 hole time goal should always be that four hour mark. The responsibility falls on the member to ensure these expectations are met. If you are approached by a marshal, you are required to make every effort to speed up between shots to ensure the rest of the field doesn't get held up. If you are a hole behind and the marshal requests that you skip a hole, this is in the best interests of the field and to ensure the best possible experience for all patrons on the day. Your understanding and cooperation in this regard would be appreciated.

### FROM EAST TO WEST

July has come and gone fairly quickly and along with that, the end of winter is now in sight. On East we have attended to the wet area on hole 7 and on inspection, we found inappropriate drainage that had been installed. We have removed the old system and replaced this with a newer system that will function better during the wet season. In addition to that, we have opened a channel to allow the water to run out of the wetland to the waterway. We are now moving on to clear out the drainage pipes on hole 13 & 14 East. Most of the veld grass pockets on East have been cut and we will now move across to the West course.

We had a major irrigation pipe line repair on hole 5 West. The main gravity line that feeds the West pumpstation was leaking, causing standing water on the left hand side of the green. The steel pipe that had been installed, started to rust and crumble opening holes in the pipe. A new system will be installed to link into the PVC pipe past the steel pipe to avoid us using the steel pipe and disturb the old system. Fortunately, this hole is closed for play due to the renovation which gave us some freedom to work with no disturbance or inconvenience caused to golfers.

August is going to be a very busy month for the maintenance team in terms of various projects and course treatments taking place. The first week of August we will start with the removing of the sediment in the dam next to the 13th East tee box, top up bunkers on the East course and also scarify tee's & fairways on the West course. We plan to start work on the bark beds on East by the end of August as soon as the bunker top up is completed. The driving range tee levelling is also planned to start on 22 August.

The West course project is moving swiftly along, with seven green complexes having already been shaped and grassing on six of them has been completed. By the end of July, ten greens would have been fumigated and the remaining holes will be done during the first week of August. The plastic covers will stay on for ten days after which, they will be removed to do final shaping and floating of the greens before seeding that will commence around 22 August. All players on the West course are instructed to please stay away from the greens moving forward, as the chemicals applied for fumigation are dangerous and once the greens are seeded, all players are asked to stay away from the area to avoid any disruption of the progress.

I am extremely excited about the look the West course will have – the course is going to be fun to play, with new additional bunkers and grasses down bunker faces.

Bunkers are frustrating places to visit, but by following the correct rules and etiquette, all golfers can help themselves and fellow golfers escape this unnecessary situation. You will also boost your own standing amongst fellow members and playing partners, as a considerate and responsible player.

The Club has invested considerable funds into our bunkers and the course staff take great care in preparing the bunkers every morning, ahead of play, but it requires all golfers to rake any bunker they have been in and to ensure the bunkers remain playable and presentable for all, throughout the day. Please rake your bunkers and encourage your fellow golfers to do the same.



### BEE NEWS

As the winter cold sets in, the bees have been extremely busy adapting to their new home. The second apairy site has already been chosen and will house 5 empty boxes for the up and coming swarm season which usually begins late August, these boxes are placed in the trees close to the fence on the 2nd hole of East facing huddle Park and with any bees, swarming can happen at anytime through the year as this is nature. A routine Spring inspection will happen once the nights get warmer and the days get longer which is one of two inspections beekeepers do annually to check on health of the colony and for pests, this will happen towards the beginning of August. I spent the early chilly, frosty morning with the green keeping staff as they started with their winter cuttings and it went very smoothly around the hives as vibrations, noise and heat will create alot of confusion and anger when it comes to bees stinging anything and anyone in a 1km area thus all precautions were taken prior to cutting and supervised for safety. This will make the boxes more visually accessible with lower grass and curious eyes but I urge golfers to stay on the beautiful cut grass path heading towards the beautiful cut fairways and take a drop if necessary for your safety and fellow golfers as this area will remain a no entry zone.

At this point, there is only 3 wild colonies(meaning not in a hive or catch box) noted on the East championship course which to remind golfers where they are situated, one down towards the green on the 3rd hole of east in the lower part of the tree on the right side approaching the green, one in the old tree on the left towards the bridge on the 6th hole which has been there for years and one in the bushwillow over hanging the small dam of the 16th tee box at the back, all these colonies are calm at present and there has been no reports of naughty bees to date.

Plans for west course will commence only once the course is opened fully again and all zones for construction have been investigated.
