FROM THE CLOCK TOWER

The first signs of spring are starting to show, with the trees beginning to develop new buds and this would be evident if you had played recently.

The West course refurbishment is progressing well, is on schedule and has now entered its' second phase with the seeding of the greens. The West greens are being resurfaced with bent grass (latest USGA spec) and the bunkers reshaped with new drainage, liners and sand. The improvements are to suit modern play – all the renovated bunkers will be shallower and have slightly rolled down grass faces. The liners will help prevent contamination of the sand and overall, will lower our maintenance costs. The aim is to present a far more enjoyable and fun course and ensure an offering that appeals to everyone, from the beginner to the professional. The West course remains set to reopen at the end of November and we cannot wait to showcase both courses this coming summer!

At the time of writing this months column, we have successfully completed our annual financial audit with HLB, for the year ending 30 June 2022 and our auditors continue to show satisfaction with the Club's accounting practices, good governance and standard operating procedures.

As we come out of the debilitating effects of Covid, which punctured our ability to host functions and corporate events for the majority of the financial year, we were plunged into daily load shedding and unimaginable rainfall levels last summer (1320mm of rain vs 810mm the previous summer). This equated to a minimum loss in revenue of R3m, however, despite the macro environment, we have achieved a break-even result for the financial year. This includes the startup costs of our new facilities (Old Oak & Gym) and the investments made into generators and solar for our pump stations, which has eliminated our greatest risk of not being able to irrigate greens on the hot summer days.

The financial statements will be presented at the 131st Annual General Meeting (21 September 2022) and as always, the abridged results will be published in the Royal Review (9th edition). My sincere appreciation to our finance team, Charlotte de Jong & Siobhan Bersiks, for their diligent efforts and for delivering another seamless performance, this with the added pressure of large capital projects throughout the year.

The close of our year end, shows the pro-active measures taken to not only protect and scale the business but align the Club with the challenging landscape, across golf, functions and hospitality. We have continued to keep the revenue and expenditure gaps closed, whilst at the same time increasing the overall value proposition. Additionally, we are pleased to communicate, for the fifth consecutive year, that the Club has retained a 5-star occupational health & safety rating. Special thanks to our infrastructure manager, Hennie Bredenhann, for consistently delivering the highest of safety standards at our facility. We have accomplished an enormous amount the year and our combined efforts confirm how Royal remains dedicated to success and future generations.

The notice of the 131st Annual General Meeting has been distributed to the membership (Thursday, 1 September 2022) this will be followed by the Royal Review publication (annual report) on 9 September 2022. This year's publication will again be edited by the infamous, Dan Retief and its promises to be another great read. With a new season comes renewed hopes for better golf. As the fairways become greener and the greens become softer through the spring and summer, we ask all players to fix their pitch marks and fill their divots as it's paramount to the golf courses staying in their best condition.

In the final round of the US Open 2022 the world number 1-Scottie Scheffler, blasted his first tee shot down the fairway only to be met by a divot which had not been filled. He then managed to play the most unbelievable iron shot onto the green and subsequently made birdie to add to his tally. From time to time, we manage to find a fairway or two in our round of golf and on the rare occasion in the obscenest place (the middle of the fairway) our ball comes to rest in an unrepaired divot. Currently we have the luxury of marking our ball and placing it within a scorecard's length on a neat perch. But... I have bad news.... Handicaps South Africa has made a call to many Clubs around South Africa, to align with the world handicapping system. It has become the norm to have preferred lies at many Clubs around the country however it is not endorsed by the World Handicap System and should only be used by committees when there are adverse conditions that require the rule to be temporarily instilled. The most important rule of golf from the beginning is that the ball should be played as it lies. We will be removing placing in the coming weeks once the fairways have recovered from the scarifying process and will only be instilling placing when conditions require. This is to ensure we stay within the true rules of the Royal and Ancient and to heed the call of Handicaps South Africa. The enjoyment of the game of golf at its' core is that it is not perfect and bad breaks are common.

FROM EAST TO WEST

From the start of August the maintenance team has been extremely busy with numerous projects on course. Scarifying of all tees and fairways was completed by mid-August, which was much earlier than we had anticipated. This allowed us to immediatly move across to the East course, rather than at the start of September. The approaches and surrounds on West will be done as soon as the new sods have knitted properly to assist with grow in, to tie in better with the surrounds, hence the reason this has not been done yet. All tees, approaches and surrounds on East have been scarified and the fairways are also going as planned. The front nine on East has been scarified and the team is now moving across to the back nine where scarifying will be completed by end of August. We know that this is an irritation for golfers, but it is such an important treatment that has to be done to allow us to have such beautiful fairways in summer. The thatch must be knocked out to allow new growth to come through quicker and to have those beautiful tightly knitted fairways that look like carpets. We are now just waiting for our rains to come and then we will be fertilising both courses.

The sediment island on 13 East has been cleared out. We have removed about two feet of silt over the area and the bull rushes have been removed, restoring the aesthetic value. This will be an ongoing maintenance practice for the next couple of years until the property development up towards the storage dam has renovated the waterway and no more sediment can be washed in to the pond.

We have also completed the annual bunker sand top-up on the East course. We first checked the sand levels across the bunkers, moved the sand around where needed and if there was any excess sand in an area and only then did we add in sand. Some bunkers required extra sand and some not.

What is concerning, as the course manager is, even with the bunkers being attended to and the team raking the bunkers to perfection each morning, golfers still tend to leave bunkers 'un-raked' and exit the bunkers on the high sides. Through covid, golf etiquette has been neglected by many, in terms of leaving the course in a better way than how you find it.


I kindly ask that you talk to your playing partners to rake the bunkers after they or you have been in them, exit the bunker on the lower side as this will ensure the faces stay firm and allow the ball to run to the base and minimise plugged lies in the faces.



In September we will be planning to top-up the bark beds on East and clearing them from weeds. The West course renovation is moving along very swiftly. Construction work on the front nine is now fully completed, with only a few areas of grassing left to be done. The new fairway bunker on the second hole is also done, and the newly located fairway bunker on the third is also complete. Fumigation of the greens was completed and followed by final floating and seed. This will allow for the seed to germinate and by the 2 September we should see growth. Giving a full three months for grow in to commence and be ready for play on opening. The biggest part of the project is now done. The back nine construction is not as big as the front nine and this process should be finished by the end of September. The team will also be focusing on grow in as from now, the bunker sand installation will commence at the end of October, allowing the sand time to settle in before re opening. I urge all golfers to stay away from the greens during seeding, we cannot afford any damage to them as the timeline is tight and we need a full germination on our schedule to be able to deliver superb greens come November. The end is coming near with only three months left until the course will re-open again – it will be worth the wait.

The driving range tee levelling, new greens and bunkers are also underway and the enhancement will be a fantastic practice facility.

Thank you for all your support and we now look ahead to summer golf!







There is nothing more frustrating than hitting your ball into a bunker and finding, on arrival, that your ball is sitting at the bottom of someone else's divot or footprint. Over the past couple of months, we have noticed an alarming number of bunkers left 'unraked', particularly on member days.

Bunkers are frustrating places to visit, but by following the correct rules and etiquette, all golfers can help themselves and fellow golfers escape this unnecessary situation. You will also boost your own standing amongst fellow members and playing partners, as a considerate and responsible player.

The Club has invested considerable funds into our bunkers and the course staff take great care in preparing the bunkers every morning, ahead of play, but it requires all golfers to rake any bunker they have been in and to ensure the bunkers remain playable and presentable for all, throughout the day. Please rake your bunkers and encourage your fellow golfers to do the same.

"In golf, customs of etiquette and decorum are just as important as rules governing play. It is the enthusiasm, passion, respect and support of our Club members, which enables us to offer these wonderful facilities. To offer a great experience it takes the cooperation of all patrons using the course to uphold the guidelines, culture and standards. Golf is a game of great integrity; there are no referees on the course and it's every golfers responsibility to respect each other, the game and the facility we play. Bee keeping tactics 101

An inspection was done on the 31st July which is part of the annual inspection getting the hives ready for spring. We have seen a late flower from the eucalyptus trees and an early flower from certain trees, warmer mornings and later afternoons will have the bees active longer in the days and earlier in the mornings than expected. The general health of both colonies are doing well with no diseases or pests noticed, I have taken off the super on the younger colony just to allow them to fill the brood box completely. The biggest colony is still working on their super and hopefully by the end of December we might see some honey , holding thumbs We urge golfers to avoid playing their golf ball from this area and suggest taking a penalty drop with a smile.

Apairy set up.

Two sites have been set up at this moment with another three still planned. Site number two is on the 2nd hole of east hidden in the trees with one of the four boxes already housing bees caught on this site. This is a good sign for the apairy site with bees already taking occupation in one of the boxes.

No other noticeable wild colonies have been found on the East course besides for the colony along the rough line in the last tall tree before the green on the 3rd hole, these bees are well established in the living tree and haven't caused any problems to date. The West course inspection has been completed where no wild colonies were found but will have two catch apairy sites set up for the catching of swarms with any new wild colonies identified and tagged during the summer months. Wild colonies will be identified with a Blue tag and shouldn't be approached at any time.

When you hear the bees on the trees, don't panic, stand still and listen to their beautiful melody, a song like no other as spring approaches so the bees get excited. Spring is fast approaching so the bees will be alot more active with beautiful flowers waiting for them and the trees being one of their favorites.



RUHAN'S WINE COLUMN

HidAs we explored hidden gems in The Old Oak's Wine Cellar in last month's article, I would like to shift focus on not only the wonderful wines on offer, but also the very extensive spirits in our bar. With our from exceptional offering various international producers you can experience some of the finest spirits the world has to offer. I would like to introduce Calvados, France's historic apple brandy from Normandy. Although this may invoke visuals of D-Day or the island abbey of Mont Saint-Michel, the region should also conjure up a few delicious images as the region of Normandy produce some of the finest creamy cheeses, dry cider and most prominently, Calvados. An apple brandy produced exclusively in the region, the spirit keeps being underestimated and overlooked by patrons all over.



So let's start by asking, what is Calvados?

Calvados is an apple brandy with Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée (AOC) status. It can only beproduced in Normandy and much like Cognac, is a specific brandy that can only be distilled from white wine made within a particular region from certain grapes. However, Calvados isn't distilled from wine grapes. It begins as cider and while a small percentage of perry pears is permitted, the base cider is made primarily from apples. These must be grown in Normandy, where more than 200 varieties are cultivated. Producers can use four types of apples: sweet, bittersweet, bitter and bitter sharp. The fruit is pressed and fermented, then distilled into an eau-de-vie (colourless fruit brandy) and aged at least two years in oak.



The first written records of apple eau-de-vie and apple brandy date to the 1500s, but it wasn't until the 19th century, when phylloxera destroyed countless European vineyards and decimated France's Cognac supply, that Calvados enjoyed much popularity beyond its' birthplace. Some producers believe in the fruit in the bottle whereby an apple is grown inside of a glass bottle to encapsulate Normandy's great produce and constantly have the fruit in contact with the Brandy.

Calvados is great for after dinner drinks as it's not overly complex. It is also great in cocktails – replace Cognac with Calvados when you are preparing a French Connection Cocktail, or serve it in a heated glass to elevate all of those apple and caramel flavours.


