

THE GOLF DEPARTMENT

It seems like we've skipped spring and gone straight into summer. For those summer players who have been hibernating and hiding the clubs in the cupboard, it's time to dust them off and join us for what looks like a beautiful warm season. The courses are greening up week by week and are starting to look sublime. Our junior league side has secured their promotion to the next division with a critical win against Ruimsig, who were in second position. The team led this season by captain Tayo Straw, had a few great results and deserve a massive pat on the back for showing resilience in some down to the wire fixtures. The star studded Mid-Am A side have won their league with a fixture in hand and can be very proud of the consistent season in a tough A division pool.

We ask all members and their guests to always keep in mind their position on the course. Speed of play is always a hot topic in the game, and we ask all to always attempt to keep up with the fourball ahead. If you walk onto a tee box and the group ahead is on the green (on a par 4), you are out of place and need to speed up. In addition to this, we ask all members making bookings to adhere to our booking policy of cancellation of at least 48 hours prior to allow the golf department to fill the gaps wherever they may be, to ensure the best experience on the course. If you end up as a 2 ball in the middle of a field, you can only expect to have a painfully slow round. As much as the player assistants can push the field, there are certain situations that simply cannot be worked out.

FROM EAST TO WEST

Spring is such a beautiful time of year as everything comes back to life after winter and the trees are a different green this time of year. The East course is starting to come alive as well and the extension of the irrigation dam has certainly helped us water a bit deeper than the usual. West is still a bit drier, mainly due to us using water sparingly for the grow in phase of the revamp. No rain is predicted till mid-October but hopefully we will get a surprise shower prior to the prediction. For now, we are still fine in terms of irrigation water and we have started transferring water from our storage dam with a fair amount of water still coming in there. We are aiming to fertilize the golf courses as soon as we have received some regular rain as last thing we want to do is fertilize the courses and we don't receive rain following the applications.

The West greens are now 5 weeks since seeding, and I need to compliment the growth thus far. They have received two applications of granular fertilizer and are being mowed daily now on 7mm. We will gradually drop the height of cut weekly to the desired height prior to the opening. Topdressing of the greens will also be happening at least twice prior to the opening and this will aid in getting the greens firmer and smoother for the play expected on the new greens. Construction of the bunkers and surrounds is also near completion with only the 11th West left, this will be completed by the first week of October. The first 60 tons of bunker sand will be arriving by the end of September. Installation of the sand will start first week of October aiming to complete the installation by end October and this will allow the sand to settle for a month before the opening.



The driving range tee levelling has been a huge success. Unfortunately we could not level out the front tee as planned and had to create a three-step tier of tee boxes - this was mainly due to us hitting large rock below the surface. The sods have knitted and rooted very well and I believe the tee will be ready for use the in the first week of October.

From the 3rd of October, we will start with regular light dusting of the East greens and we aim to do this practice every 14 days followed by light grooming of the greens. The amount of sand applied will gradually reduce as we progress into this planned maintenance practice.

Spring is an exciting yet difficult time of year when water is becoming limited as we await the much anticipated rainfall to come. Fingers crossed we get some rain within the next two weeks so that we can fertilize the golf course.







Appeal to Members Plense rake your Bunkers!



There is nothing more frustrating than hitting your ball into a bunker and finding, on arrival, that your ball is sitting at the bottom of someone else's divot or footprint. Over the past couple of months, we have noticed an alarming number of bunkers left 'unraked', particularly on member days.

Bunkers are frustrating places to visit, but by following the correct rules and etiquette, all golfers can help themselves and fellow golfers escape this unnecessary situation. You will also boost your own standing amongst fellow members and playing partners, as a considerate and responsible player.

The Club has invested considerable funds into our bunkers and the course staff take great care in preparing the bunkers every morning, ahead of play, but it requires all golfers to rake any bunker they have been in and to ensure the bunkers remain playable and presentable for all, throughout the day. Please rake your bunkers and encourage your fellow golfers to do the same.

"In golf, customs of etiquette and decorum are just as important as rules governing play. It is the enthusiasm, passion, respect and support of our Club members, which enables us to offer these wonderful facilities. To offer a great experience it takes the cooperation of all patrons using the course to uphold the guidelines, culture and standards. Golf is a game of great integrity; there are no referees on the course and it's every golfers responsibility to respect each other, the game and the facility we play. We attended to the bees after receiving a call from the head greenkeeper Mr Jerry, with no stings recorded to greenkeeping staff or golfers, play resumed as normal with plenty gimmy putts, flag dropping and a very fortunate queen find.
