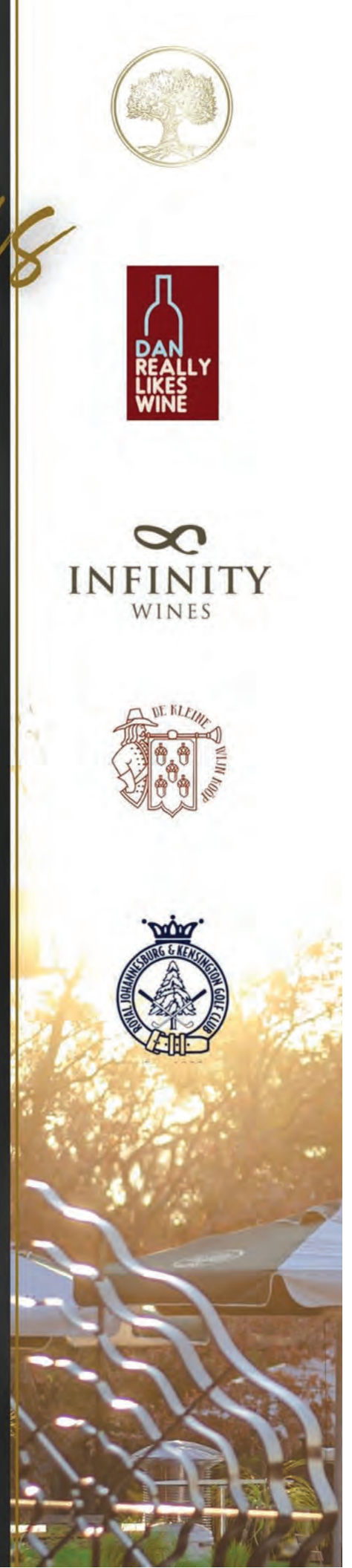

The dazzling jacarandas are out and It always amazes me how these trees sit so quietly, unnoticed all spring, until one day it feels as if every single one throughout the city bursts with velvet blossoms at the exact sametime and boy is It beautiful.

The West course renovation is progressing well, is on time and on budget and the members can see the new product coming together. We are in the final stages and the course conditioning is now underway. The team are working through the process of implementing the course furniture, scorecards and everything that will bring this new golf experience to life. With only one month to go until the opening on 30 November, the grand opening of the course will take place over 5 days and the schedule will be shared with the membership soon, so that you can start making your bookings.



It's been another stressful yet successful month at the Club. If it isn't covid or load-shedding, we were once again faced with a flash flood on the 20th of October. Our facility received 75mm of severe rain and hail within a 30 minute window. The hail blocked all of our drains and caused flooding in the clubhouse. Management and staff immediately followed all the necessary procedures to protect the facility and to ensure the safety of our members and guests on site.

We completed a full clean up within 54 hours and all 'damaged' bunkers on the East course have been fully restored. We have implemented further risk mitigation measures for hail storms and hope the additional steps taken will avoid flooding in the future. On a positive note it was pleasing to see how well our new bunkers managed the water on the West Course and a good sign that the completed work has been done well.

The 2022 annual Festival of Golf brought to you by Tricol, was another great success. Whilst on a smaller scale this year due to the West course renovation, great fun was had by all and our sincere thanks to our property developers for another generous title sponsorship.

As per key approval by the members at the AGM we have completed our submission to the Cabinet Office to change the name of the Club from Royal Johannesburg & Kensington Golf Club to Royal Johannesburg (the name, together with the new logo, subject to all requirements within our Royal Charter). We now await feedback and hope to roll out the new corporate identity in Q1 2023.

In addition, we have reached all our objectives to finally implement padel tennis at Royal and once the agreements have been signed members will be informed of this new and exciting value proposition to the Club. The project will be at no cost to the Club, it will create a new revenue stream and a wonderful new offering to members. As we enter the final stretch of 2022, the Club has some fantastic events coming up, which include; Carols by Candlelight and the warm return of Ashleigh Buhai. Keep an eye out for bookings.

The year end Board meeting is set to take place on 1 December and the Board hopes to finalise the proposals received around solar and the joint venture of the lodge initiative for 2023.

In closing, it was wonderful to host Honorary Life member Mr. Gary Player back to the Club in October. He played the East Course and shared many of his memories at the Club as a junior. Mr. Player complimented the East Course changes, its condition, the bunkers and most importantly noted that it was the best greens he had played in South Africa in recent times, so good that he's promised he will return whenever possible. Mr Player extended his congratulations to the Club on the numerous upgrades, enhancements and superb service.

THE GOLF DEPARTMENT

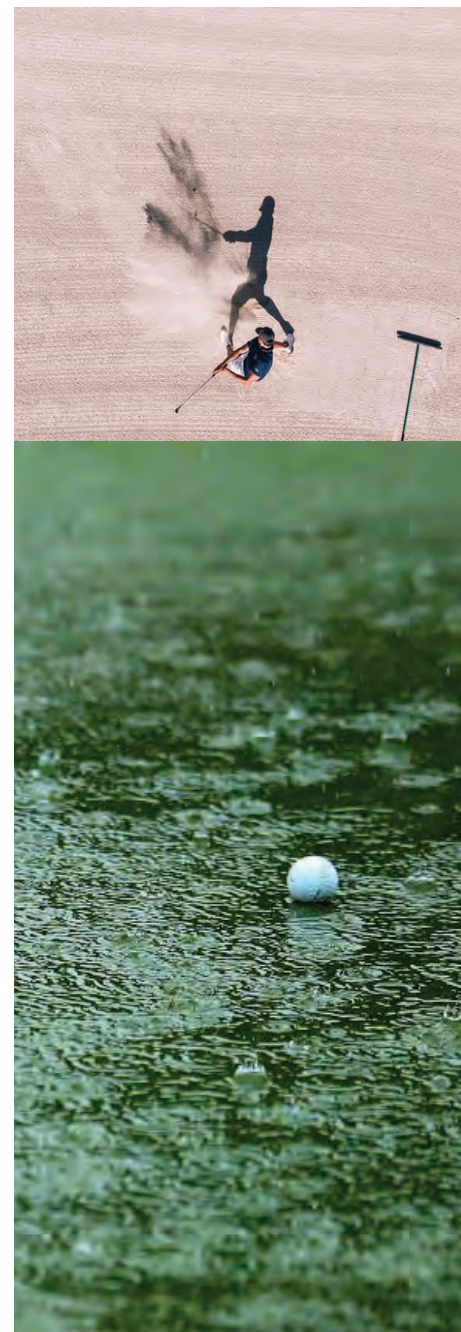

With a wet start to our warm season, the courses will be in brilliant condition in the coming weeks and months, but with that comes a few more house rules that will need to be instilled from time to time and we urge all golfers to abide by them to ensure our courses stay damage free for as long as possible.

Firstly, we ask all players to repair their pitch marks on our pure greens! This is non-negotiable for every player and if you haven't made a pitch mark, fix someone else's! All players who use a cart are to please use the 90-degree rule as this avoids damaging the fairways. The concern around the state of our bunkers throughout a field has been a battle over the last few months as many have forgotten which end of the rake to use once they are finished playing their shot.

Lastly a reminder to all golfers of our lightning policy. The storms passing through our area carry a massive amount of lightning. A storm that passed the Club on Saturday the 22nd of October which consisted of 16 cells in the Gauteng area, was carrying more than 4500 strikes per minute!

We all know how fatal a strike can be. If the siren is blown, play is expected to stop immediately and players are expected to head back to the clubhouse. The system that we use allows us to track the storm and gives us enough information (except when a storm starts directly over the Club), to evacuate the courses safely. The rain shelters on the golf courses are not lightning safe and can be a deadly mistake if caught under there during a storm.



The 2022 league season has been a highly successful season for all Royal sides. The ladies weekday 1 team played outstanding golf all season which culminated in the team winning the ladies league! Our Mid-Am A side dominated the league and have won the title. The juniors managed to stave off a few tough games to win their respective division. The scratch league first side has one game left to play and lead their division by a point, however the second place CCJ is the final fixture, and the game is at CCJ. With a win here the Royal banner will have collected 4 division wins. The second scratch side still have an opportunity to dominate their final game and possibly get promoted back into the top division. All league players can be very proud of their efforts this year and have truly flown the Royal flag high.

FROM EAST TO WEST

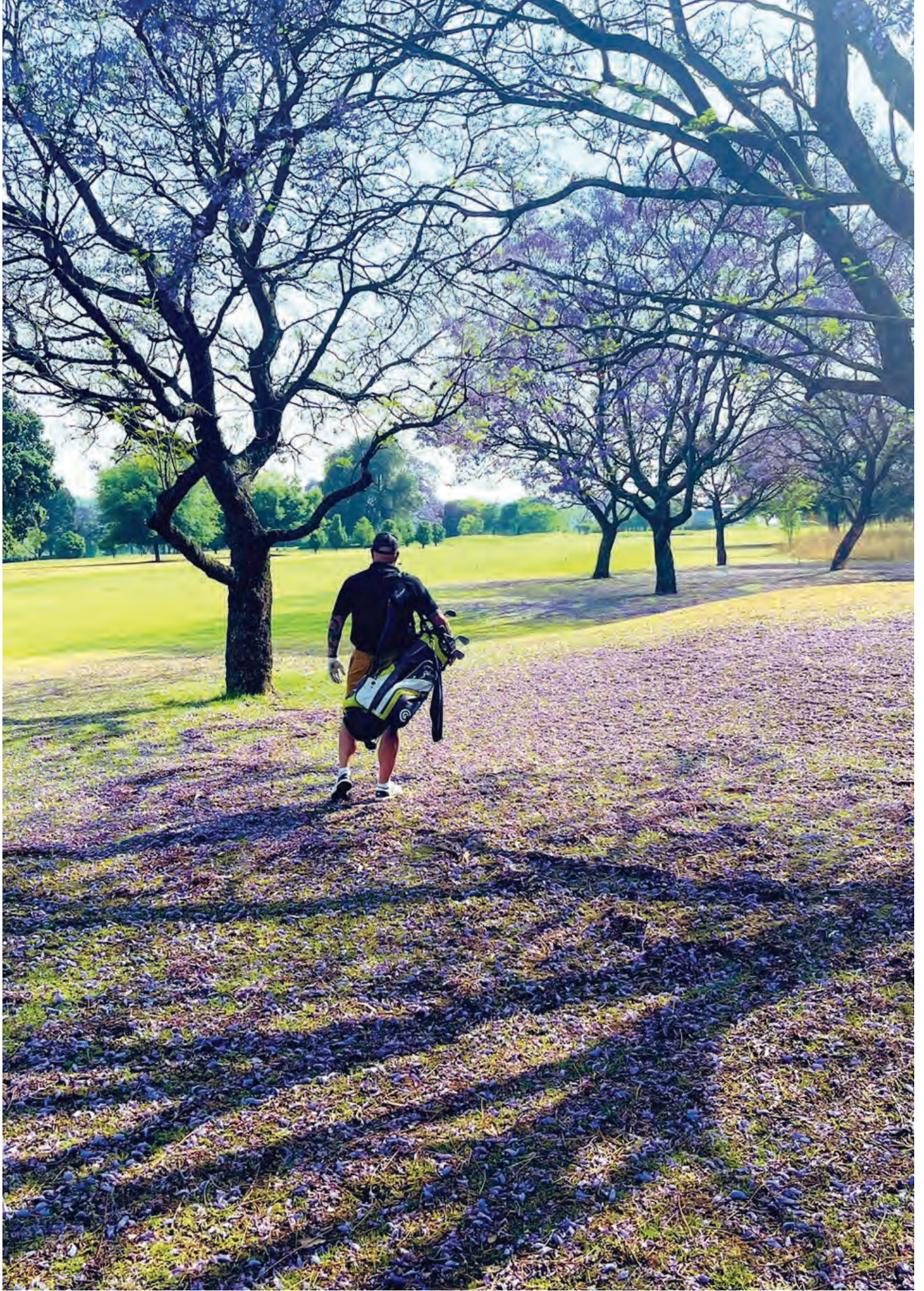
The start of October was a dry and hot couple of weeks but we ended the month well, with some wet and cool days. We finally received our first rains in the week of 17 to 21 October with a total of 78mm for the month to date. These rains were sufficient enough to water our courses well and more importantly fill up the dams again. The storm we received on the 20th October caused some untidiness but no real potential damage. The only repair we had to do was to remove some contaminated sand in a few bunkers and repair the pillar blanket on the 17th greenside bunker. The rains have also allowed us to start fertilising the courses with East being done on 24 October and West will follow and be completed in the first week of November. Soon we will have lush and beautiful golf courses again and Royal will showcase its' beauty and brutality in all aspects.

The shaping of tee boxes on both East and West will soon be correctly marked out and realigned. We will also be introducing more environ/veldgrass areas on East while removing more of the in-play areas on the West course. Planned maintenance on East for November will only include our normal light dusting of the greens.



The West course renovation is also nearing its' end and in the next newsletter we will be discussing the opening of the course. It is unbelievable how quickly six months have passed. With all construction having been completed by mid-October, bunker sand installation has started immediately. The current front nine has been completed with the back nine only having six bunkers left to fill with sand and this should be completed by no later than the end of the month. Following the storm we had, the bunkers drained very well with not a single bunker waterlogged at any point. The flash flood was the ultimate test for these bunkers and they have passed it with flying colours. Our team has also completed removing dead trees and will soon start with removing the tree stumps on both East and West – the TLB is utilised to assist with bunker sand installation. Leading up to the opening of the West course, the maintenance team will be hard at work getting the course into pristine condition.

Again we would like to thank the members for their patience during the renovation thus far. The long wait is now nearing the end and this wait will be so worth it for both the members and the maintenance teams.

There is nothing more frustrating than hitting your ball into a bunker and finding, on arrival, that your ball is sitting at the bottom of someone else's divot or footprint. Over the past couple of months, we have noticed an alarming number of bunkers left 'unraked', particularly on member days.

Bunkers are frustrating places to visit, but by following the correct rules and etiquette, all golfers can help themselves and fellow golfers escape this unnecessary situation. You will also boost your own standing amongst fellow members and playing partners, as a considerate and responsible player.

The Club has invested considerable funds into our bunkers and the course staff take great care in preparing the bunkers every morning, ahead of play, but it requires all golfers to rake any bunker they have been in and to ensure the bunkers remain playable and presentable for all, throughout the day. I have introduced two special old vintages from Neil Ellis that offer great value and exceptional quality. Be on the look out for a stunning Neil Ellis Grenache 2010 and a Neil Ellis Syrah 2005. We were very fortunate to have tasted these extraordinary wines recently with winemaker and guild member Warren Ellis and Gauteng sales manager Kirsten Brabant. These wines showed beautifully on the day and are a great addition to our selection in the cellar. Stocks are limited so be sure to try them before they are gone.

The 2010 Grenache was sourced from 55-year-old bush vines in the Piekenierskloof, with a vibrant crimson colour, perfumed, spicy and a rich plummy fruit. A medium bodied palate with good weight. Fine grained fruit tannins complement a rich concentrated palate.

The 2005 Syrah from Jonkershoek has incense wood, notes of spice, pepper and soft sweet berry fruit, with dark toasted wood on the nose. Flavors of cherry, blackberry, mocha, roasted meat and spice makes for a superb soft and elegant wine.

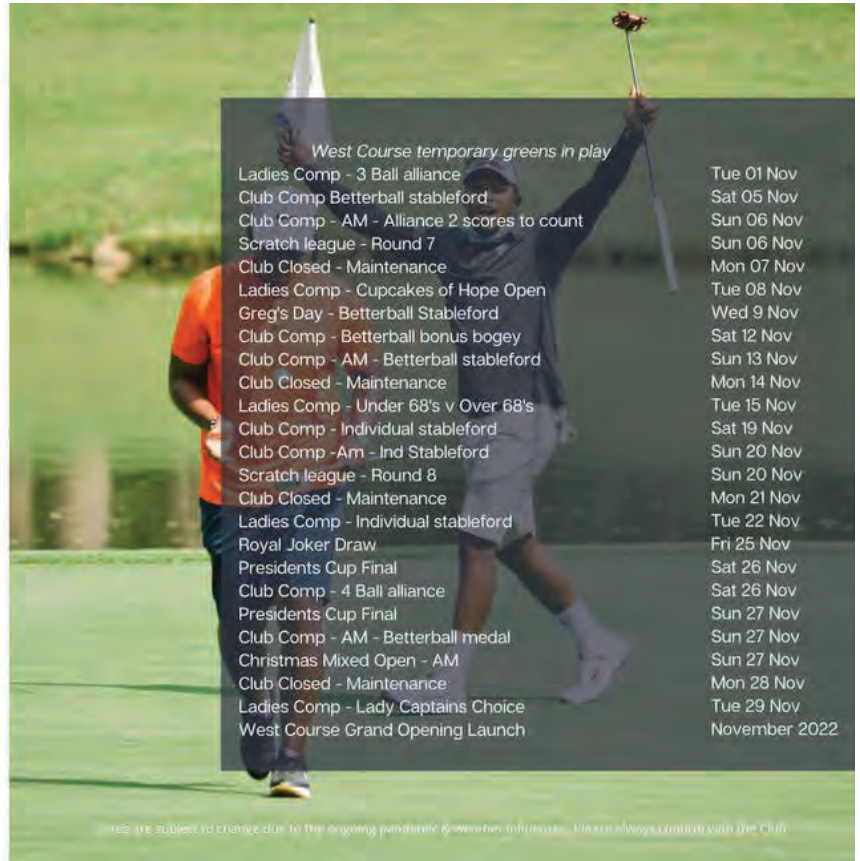
