



The course department will be carrying out hollow-tining of the West course greens in the first week of October (2-5 October).



FROM EAST TO WEST

JERRY STEYN, COURSE MANAGER



I can't believe our first month of spring has passed - time certainly does not stand still for anything. The first month of spring has been hot and chilly, but we have just received our first rainfall (14mm).

With the arrival of the first rain, our fertilising of the golf courses tees and fairways will commence soon, but we will be very conserving in our approach this summer season due to the warnings of an extreme El Nino.

The greens on both courses have already been fertilised over the past two weeks and so will be a bit slower than normal, but this is in preparation for the growing season approaching us. The West greens are scheduled for hollow-tining from the 2nd October and we are certainly looking forward to the greens after their recovery. The recovery should be quicker than normal due to the fertilizer already taking affect and the greens growing rapidly.

The first tees that were levelled in June are fully recovered and the second the second set will be ready for use in the next week. As soon as these tees are ready for use, we will complete the remainder of the tees on West and then proceed to the Par three tees on East.

During September the teams on both East and West have been hard at work ensuring that all bunkers are consistent with sand levels. We have also re-trained staff on consistent preparation of the bunkers with probes given to each nine to consistently check the levels each day. The bunkers remain our most time consuming maintenance area on both courses and we, the course staff, see on a daily basis, how golfers negatively impact the consistency of raking bunkers behind themselves! This not only impacts the next golfer when he or she lands in your footprint, but sets a bad example for the next generation of golfers. The term " leave the course in a better condition than found" needs to be implemented in the mindset of all golfers and this is not only applicable to bunkers but also to pitchmark repairing and divot filling as well.

No golfer likes to see thousands of holes punched into their greens, but temporary disruption is a fair trade for future playing conditions.



Why do greens have to be aerated in the first place?



Aeration provides a host of benefits for our hardworking putting surfaces. It helps to relieve the compaction that comes with intense golfer and maintenance traffic.

Aeration also improves air and water movement through the soil, which yields healthier grass and more consistent playing conditions. Breaking up the layer of organic material that accumulates just below the putting surface – commonly referred to as thatch – is another important benefit. The end result is firmer, smoother and healthier greens.



Be prepard for the lush fairways and stunning views once more around the facility as Jerry and his team bring the course back to life. Under the risk management profile. it was determined to remove three colonies of bees. The first removal was a colony of bees occupying a valve box in the garden's of the 10th tee box. This colony was over a year old with the box and garden area inaccessible to maintenance staff to clean or access the valve. The second removal was the 3rd hole of along the championship course, this colony of bees were occupying the base of the propolis tree closet to the green.

It was decided to trap the bees for the preservation of the tree which is a process of forcing the bees out with a cone shape device placed over the cavity of the tree where the bees were using as their entrance. It was discovered that there were multiple cavities made by the tree over time and the bees which

made the trap out take slighty longer than expected. With patience, daily monitoring and advising to the H.O.Ds, I'm happy to say that both the bees and the tree were not harmed in any process of the removal.



The bees have been relocated to a secret location and the tree was not affected structurally at all with foam filler sprayed inside the cavity to protect it from future colonies. The third removal was from another valve box lid near the staging area and 9th green. We are in the swarm season which runs from the 01.09.2023 to 29.03.2024, this will result in plenty bee swarm movements through the facility grounds. When noticing a swarm, the first tell tell signs will be a couple bees prior to the swarm moving through. You will then hear a humm noise with high vibrations felt.

The swarm movements are due to the bees looking or moving towards a new home and are considered the least dangerous of all bee colony behaviors unless provoked.

We urge golfers to observe the trees during this period as they do make a lovely humming noise. Remember this is not a swarm in the tree but thousands of bees from different colonies making sure you get the greenest trees and gardens this summer.


He has made huge improvements, including the development of the range shop and golf simulator room.
