The Club welcomed some 300 members, guests and residents to the final and the celebrations continued well into the morning. It was the perfect end to an incredible Festival of Golf week and personally, an occasion I will never forget, as one of the best events I have ever been part of at the Club.

Viva le France... the 2023 Festival of Golf brought to you by Tricolt, was a standout festival of great fun and our sincere thanks to our property developers for another generous title sponsorship as well as all the other companies who contributed to this year's success. Thank you to all the members who supported and participated and to our special staff, who worked tirelessly to pull it all off.

Earlier in the month the Club announced that our East Championship Course claimed its 5th World Golf Award! The 10th annual awards ceremony took place in Abu Dhabi on 24 October and saw the golf industry, press, pioneers and golf figureheads traveling from across the world to attend, where the East Course was once again named Best Golf Course in South Africa for 2023.



Another very proud moment for the members, Board and staff, as our Championship facility continues to be recognised amongst the very best on the international stage. We express our gratitude to everyone who voted for us and a heartfelt thank you to all the members who support the Club's success year after year - the only Club on the continent to with bragging rights to 5 world golf awards.

The dazzling jacarandas are out and it always amazes me how these trees sit so quietly, unnoticed all spring, until one day it feels as if every single one throughout the city bursts with velvet blossoms at the exact same time and boy, is it beautiful. In October last year we were 'mopping' up the clubhouse due to flooding, in contrast, this year has been very dry. However, at the time of writing this month's column, we have just received 36mm of gradual rainfall which will have a great effect on the courses in the coming weeks.

In this regard, it is important to note that we are heading into an El Niño summer and the Club is being very conservative with its' water for the courses.

The construction of our solar carport structure is well underway (70% complete), the battery room is finished and members can see the progress being made. The handover is set for 20 November and we look forward to having a full car park available again and of course the significant benefits of reliable and cost effective energy. In conjunction, the Club has also completed the installation of its pre-paid meters, to curb the incorrect billing cycles from COJ. We are also pleased to advise that the implementation of our water storage tanks for the Clubhouse have been completed, which will serve as insurance during periods of no water supply.

The new furniture for the patio, bar, halfway and deck starts to arrive this week and everything should be in place by 8 Nov. The new furniture will enhance your hospitality experience - it's a wonderful 'look & feel' and will be more comfortable and provide better choice of seating when at the Club.

Management is working hard behind the scenes to finalise the Club's new website with progress being meticulous and we are hoping to launch by the end of November/ early December. The new site will be easier to navigate, more attractive and provide the latest online technology.

The year-end Board meeting is set to take place on 22 November and the Board plans to review progress made and to finalise strategic plans for Q1 2024.

Now we put our weight and support behind the Proteas and pray our team can claim double World Cups! Please continue to use the Club, bring the family and enjoy your wonderful facilities.





FROM EAST TO WEST

JERRY STEYN, COURSE MANAGER

October is Jacaranda month and there is nothing more spectacular the blooming of all Jacaranda trees in Gauteng. Every year I am amazed by how many of these trees are around us. Normally their presence welcomes rain but unfortunately we have had only 2mm recorded for the month and it is certainly felt out on the courses. The El Nino is certainly making its presence felt and as predicted we are having a hot and dry spring thus far but fortunately not our worst October as in October 2019, we recorded 1,5mm followed by 178mm for November 2019 so hope is still there. For now, we will impatiently be waiting for the rain to come.

The water situation at Royal remains under pressure and we are using water conservatively due to the presence of the El Nino. The East course dam upgrade has helped us to be able to water more frequently than the West, hence the reason we were able to fertilise the East already.



Unfortunately, in these high temperatures the evapotranspiration rate is much higher than the amount of water we can supply during our watering schedule while also being cognisant of the climate change and predictions.

The West greens were hollowtined in the first week of October, holes have all been closed within a two week period following the first holes being punched. Green speeds have been slower than normal due to the aeration taking place and we will gradually be dropping mowing heights to be the same as East and green speeds will gradually also be picking up again.

The tee levelling on West is near completion and we only have two tee's left on the 17th West to complete. We have also started preserving grass on 5 East and 16 East and these tee's will be started in early November.

During September and October, we have taken the opportunity to use our scarifying clipping to build a new Kikuyu nursery of about 8000m2. This will be ample supply to sod across on both East and West, and the nursery first section is almost ready for use. This will not take us away completely from using the driving range fairway when sodding is needed but the sods are of much better quality and recover within a two week period.

ROYAL RETREAT



Knee pain during a golf swing can be caused by various factors related to the mechanics of the swing, physical condition, or even prior injuries. Here are some common causes and potential solutions:

- 4. Existing Knee Conditions: If you have a pre-existing knee condition or injury, such as arthritis or previous damage, playing golf might exacerbate the discomfort. The stress of the swing and walking the course could agitate these conditions.
- 5. Inadequate Warm-up or Conditioning: Inadequate warm-up exercises before playing, or inadequate conditioning, can lead to muscle fatigue or strain, which could manifest as knee soreness.

To alleviate knee soreness after playing golf, you can consider the following:

- Rest and Ice: Rest your knee and apply ice to reduce any swelling or inflammation.
- Compression and Elevation: Consider using a knee brace for support and elevate the leg to alleviate discomfort.
- Consult a Professional: If the soreness persists consider consulting a sports medicine specialist or physical therapist to assess any underlying issues or for guidance on injury prevention and rehabilitation.
- Stretching and Strengthening: Incorporate knee-strengthening exercises and stretches to improve joint flexibility and stability.
- Pain Management: Over-the-counter pain medications can help manage pain and inflammation.


