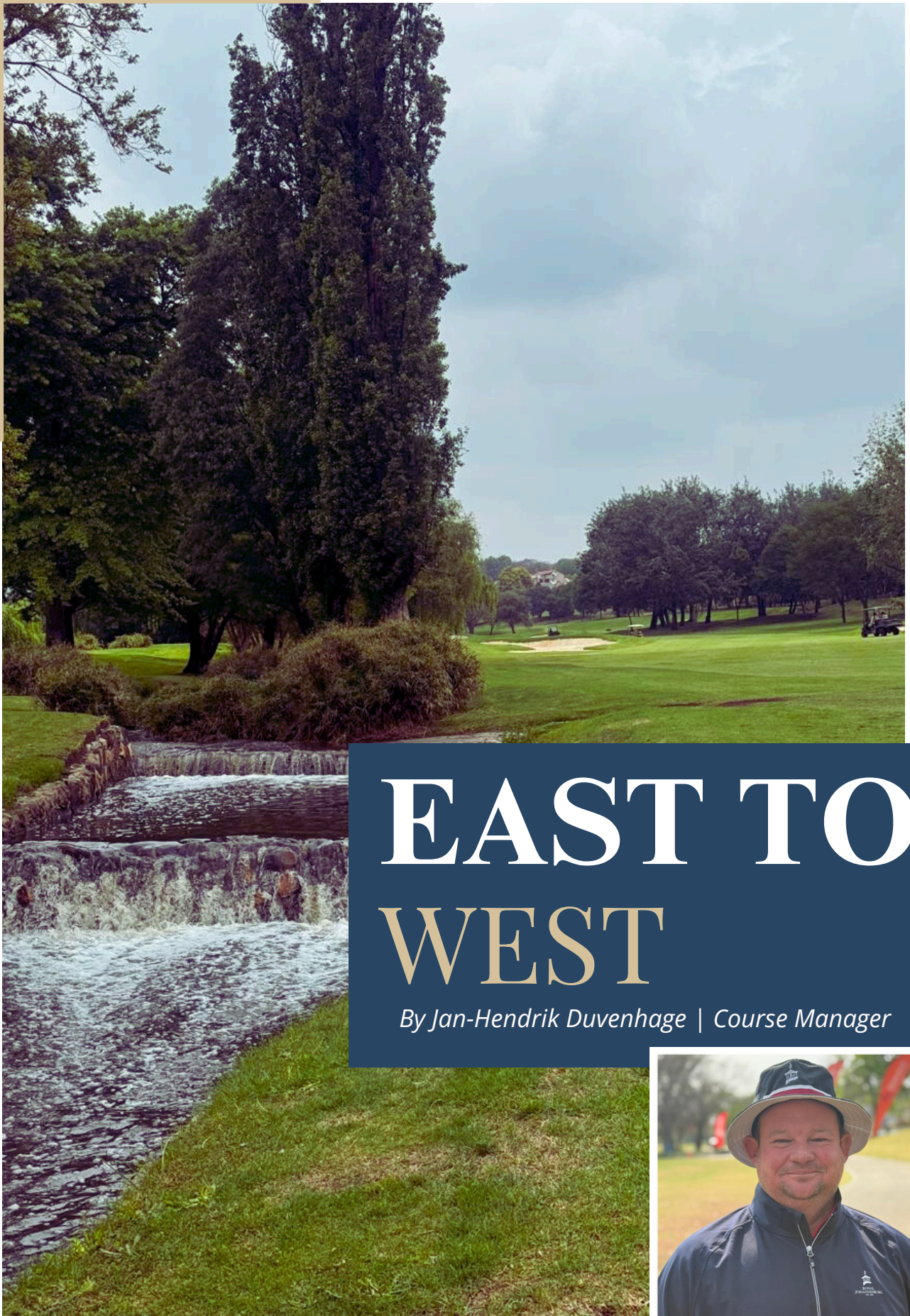

EAST TO WEST

A Strong Start to the Season at Royal Johannesburg

It all began on a crisp spring morning – the perfect start to a new chapter at Royal Johannesburg. Since stepping into this role, it's been an exciting and productive few weeks getting both the East and West courses into shape for a great season ahead.

We kicked things off on the East Course with a thorough aeration program. Tees, green surrounds, and fairways were hollow tined to allow much-needed air into the soil profile – a key step in promoting healthy turf. In addition, we treated the greens with the AIR2G2 unit, injecting approximately 1,060 m³ of air into the soil profile.

For those unfamiliar, the AIR2G2 is a fantastic tool in our turf care arsenal. It uses three probes to inject air at 6 bar of pressure, penetrating below the root zone (which sits in the top 7–10 cm of the surface). This non-invasive method fractures the sub-surface horizontally, improving drainage, reducing compaction, and encouraging healthy root development — all without damaging the turf.

Depending on soil conditions, the air may either diffuse gently into the profile or cause some surface movement as it fractures compacted layers. In either case, the outcome is a revitalized, oxygen-rich environment beneath our greens. I'm happy to report that the results have been optimal and satisfactory so far.

We've also been hard at work squaring up all the tees on both the East and West courses. This not only sharpens the visual appeal from the tee box but also helps golfers align more confidently toward the fairways. Looking ahead, the next two months will be focused on weed control — specifically targeting *Poa annua* and clover throughout both courses. This timing is crucial, allowing the kikuyu grass to fill in any gaps before the main growing season kicks into full gear.



Beyond the fairways, garden beds have started receiving fresh mulch — a process that will take some time but is essential to restoring the beauty around our clubhouse and pathways. The waterways are also getting attention, with the sides being cleared and tidied as part of a longer-term upgrade plan.

Finally, we've completed some much-needed detailing work across the course:

- Stakes and ropes have been removed, repainted, and are being selectively placed back.
- Hazard stakes have been cleaned and repositioned.
- All drainage lids have been removed, repainted, and reinstalled — small touches that make a big difference in overall presentation.

It's been a fantastic and busy start here at Royal Johannesburg. There's a lot more to come, and I'm excited to continue improving the courses with a dedicated team and a clear vision.

The Ryder Cup was an absolute humdinger! The USA were favourites playing on home soil, but the Europeans were up for the challenge! In celebration I was able to secure 1 Titleist European tour bag. It's a beauty – it sells for R14000.

I recently came back from The Links Invitational in Scotland. It was the most spectacular event competing against teams from all over the world. As you would expect the weather in the north of Scotland was a real challenge – cold, wet and windy! My team consisting of Mike Berriman, Gareth Taylor and Paul Taylor managed to come back from a 13-point deficit to win by a single point over 4 rounds of competition.

At Brora we had 40km winds and a light rain pretty much all day. Nairn was a real gem. We enjoyed clear skies but a 4 club wind again. Castle Stuart gave us the best conditions with the wind only picking up with 4 holes to play. The draw card was Royal Dornoch. One of the finest Links courses in the world. The wind was blowing at 70kph gusting over 100kph. A challenge to say the least!

To give you an idea of the strength of the wind, Mike Berriman hit his opening tee shot 266yds onto the 1st green with a 6 iron! Gareth Taylor hit a 380 yd tee shot on the stroke 1 and proceeded to 2 putt for a birdie and a 4 pointer. My claim to fame was watching my bump and run straight up the green catch a gust of wind, turned at right angles ending up in a pot bunker 40 yds away!

Our second Royal team consisting of Martin Briede, Matt Martino, John Stravides and George Mouskides held their own in trying conditions. They walked away with best dressed.





TIP OF THE MONTH

The thing I am most proud about our range is the number of junior golfers that come down to practice and take lessons. Juniors are our future. We have five wonderful coaches teaching at Royal and most of their lessons are focused on junior golfers.

Paul Leishman, our CEO, is very supportive of the development of juniors and the Clubs latest initiative is a free junior clinic every Sunday from 10am until 11am. It is open to members and non-members, who hopefully will join the club and our junior programme.

I thought I would just give some guidelines and advice to parents regarding the junior clinics. The Sunday free clinic is best suited to beginner and intermediate juniors, girls and boys from the ages of 10 until 15. The goal of this clinic to guide juniors from the range to playing on the golf course.

For the younger kids from 5 until 9 years of age, I recommend the SNAG clinics on Saturday from 9am till 10am. This clinic is much more age appropriate and suited to younger juniors.

For older and more advanced juniors I would recommend private lessons with one of our fine coaches, Gavan Levenson, Ricki Dembo, Stacey Burrowes, Keagan Beyers or me.

I was very privileged to accompany Greg Jacobs and six of our members to represent Royal Johannesburg in the Links Invitational in Scotland. It was a dream of mine to play Royal Dornoch, and it lived up to the expectation despite the hostile windy conditions. Links golf is the ultimate, it was how the game began. I would encourage members if they ever get the chance to play Links golf to grab the opportunity.

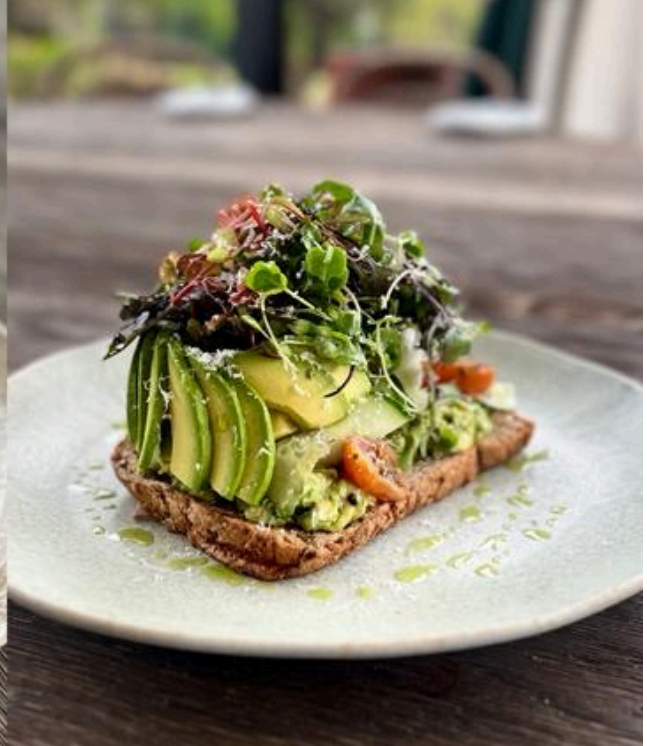
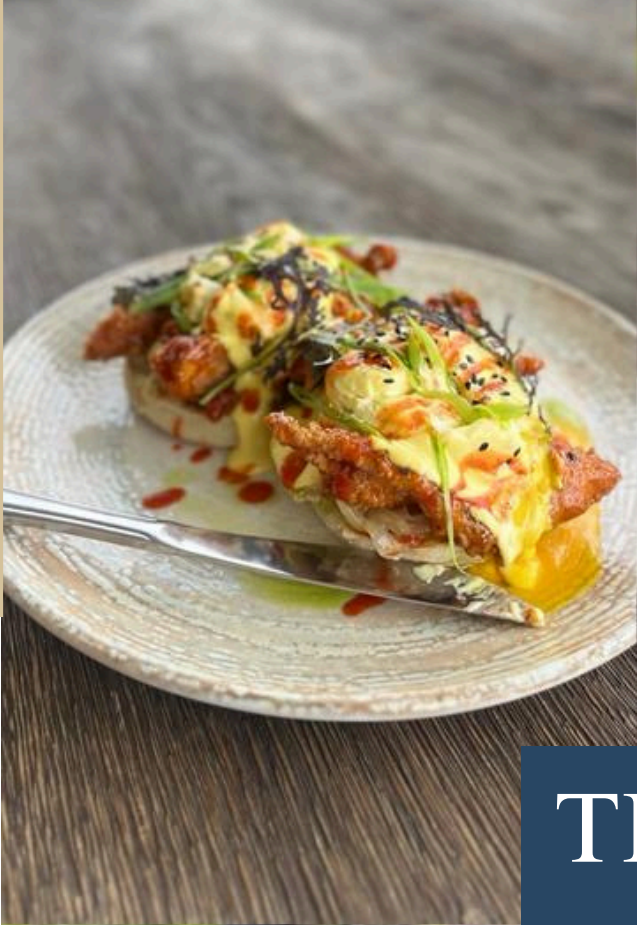

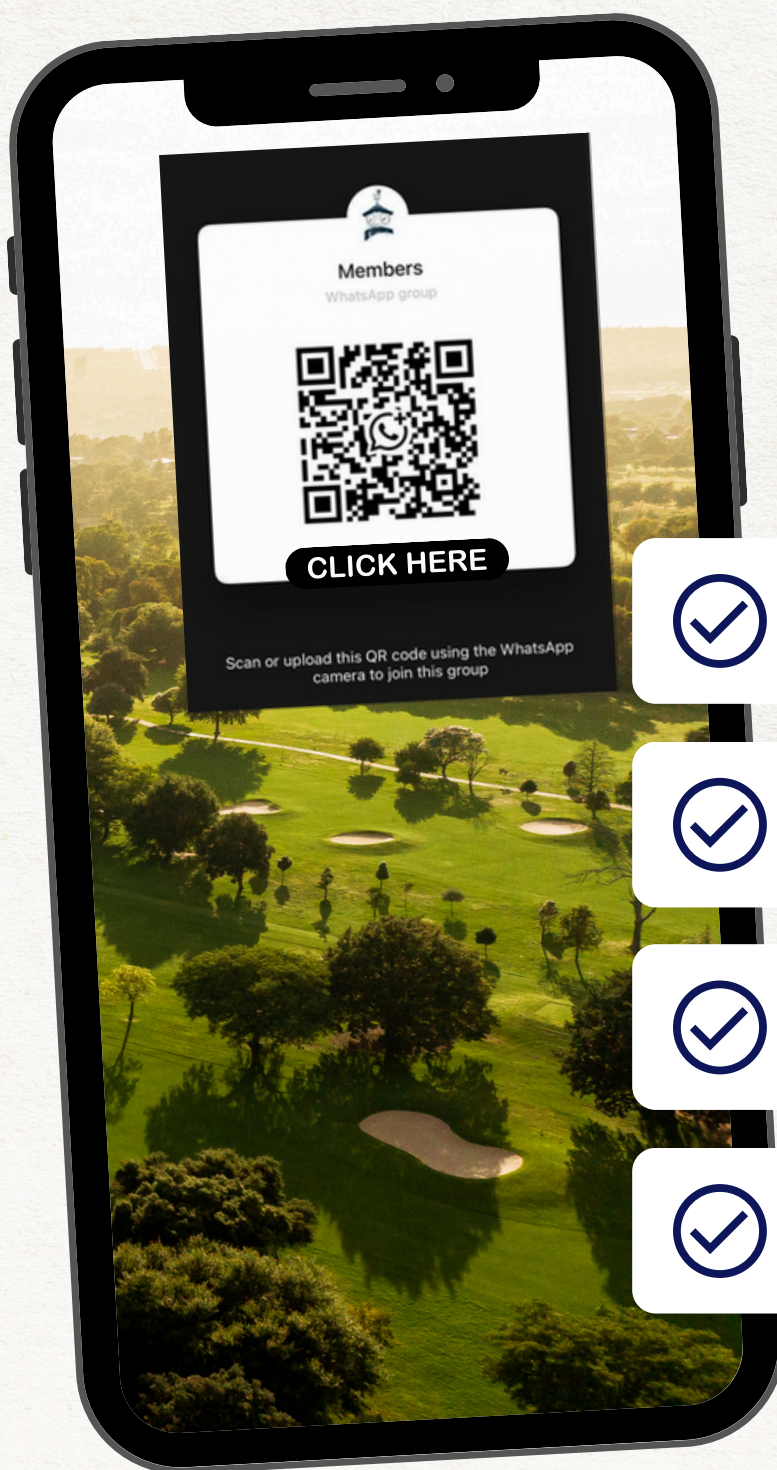
