Finally, we are now down to 40 days before the Alfred Dunhill Championship. The Championship East Course is looking amazing and it is looking like it is going to be a spectacular week. We are awaiting final plans to be signed off at which stage we will be able to communicate more information to members. We really are wanting members to get involved and enjoy this special event.

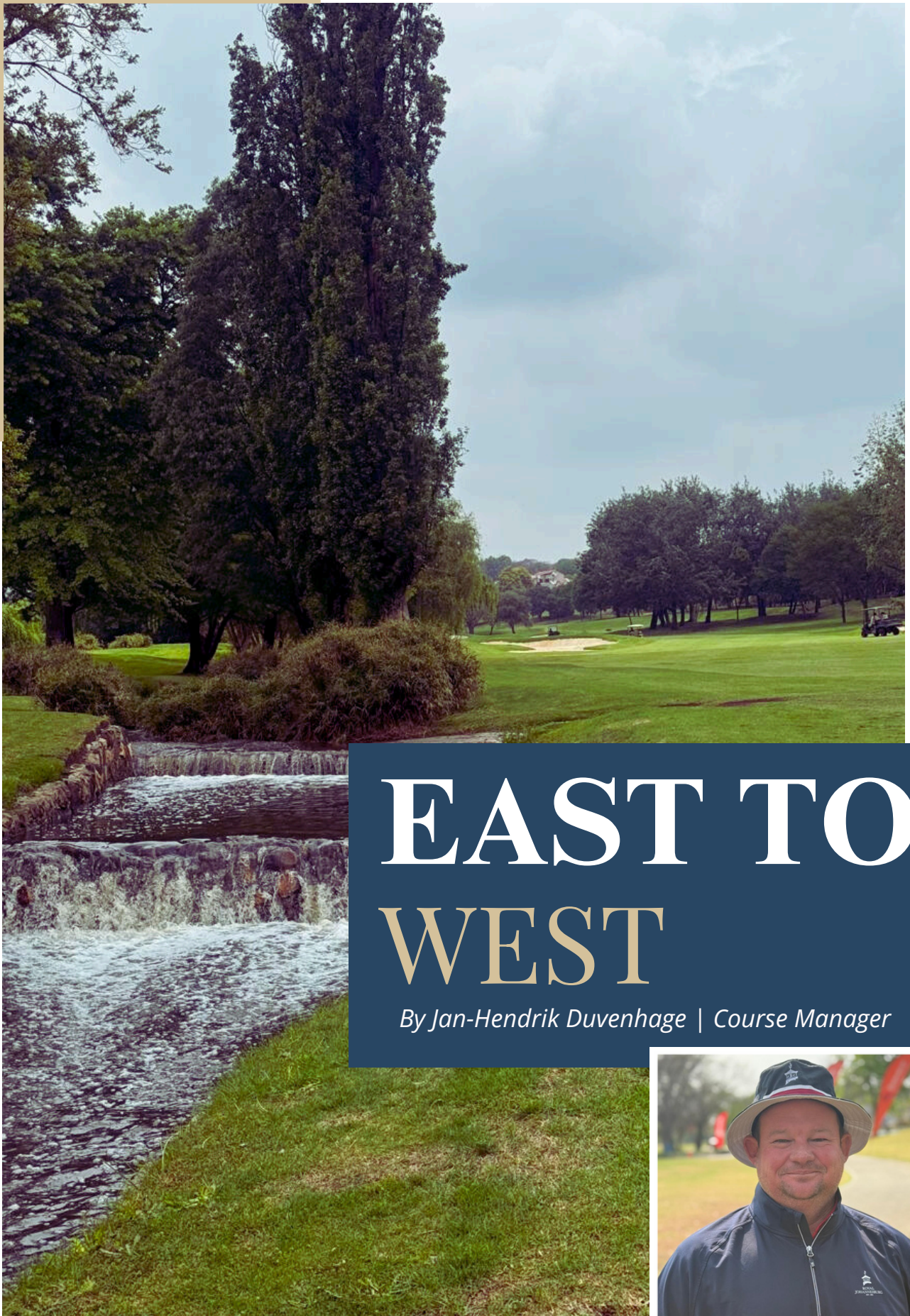

EAST TO WEST

It's been a busy and productive month on the course as we continue to prepare for the season ahead. The month began with a focus on course shaping, giving key areas a tidy refresh to improve both playability and presentation. Our team also spent time cleaning out waterways, ensuring proper drainage and smooth water flow as we move into the wetter months.

We've continued our regular weed control program, including the start of our battle against *Poa annua* in the roughs and green surrounds. The goal here is to limit the amount of *Poa annua* making its way onto the greens and to maintain strong, consistent turf surfaces. It's a long-term process, but we're seeing steady improvement.

This month also saw a full-course fertiliser application across both the West and East sides. The recent rain arrived at just the right time to help activate the nutrients, giving the turf a healthy boost heading into the next growth phase.

In some of the more shaded and challenging areas under trees—where grass struggles to grow—we've started laying down pine needles. This not only improves the overall appearance but also helps with weed suppression and soil health in those bare spots.

I'd like to thank everyone for their patience and support while we carry out these important works. Every project we complete now contributes to the quality and consistency of the playing surfaces throughout the year. See you out on the course.

TIP OF THE MONTH

Last month it was busy on the range. Royal Johannesburg hosted the Mid Am Interprovincial for golfers over the age of 35, comprising 14 teams of 8 players. This kept us busy with early morning starts with the players arriving to warm up at 05h30.

On the teaching side, our instructors have been busy. Stacey Burrowes is half way through her 'Fore the Fun of it" ladies programme. It has been really successful and will start a new 10 week programme at the beginning of next year.

This month we are hosting the Central Gauteng Golf Union Open from Friday 7th November, until Sunday 9th of November, so just bear in mind the range will be very busy during the warm up periods from 06h00 until 08h00 and again from 10h30 until 12h30 so plan your practicing accordingly.



This month's tip is on green reading. Few would argue that Bobby Locke was the finest putter ever and he was a phenomenal reader of the greens. He concentrated particularly on a radius of about three feet around the hole. He checked the lie of the turf around the hole to see the direction of the grain. He suggested that two-thirds of the hole will be cleanly cut and the rest will have a ragged or unevenly cut side. Have a look at the photo below I took on the course demonstrating this. Obviously on freshly cut holes this will be less obvious. The ball will break towards the ragged side due to the grain and slope. If you are unsure of the break or want to seek confirmation give the Bobby Locke method a try.

Finally I caught Gavan “legs” Levenson practicing on the range the other day, view the 1985 South African Open Champion’s swing below by clicking on the video and maybe pick up a tip or two.

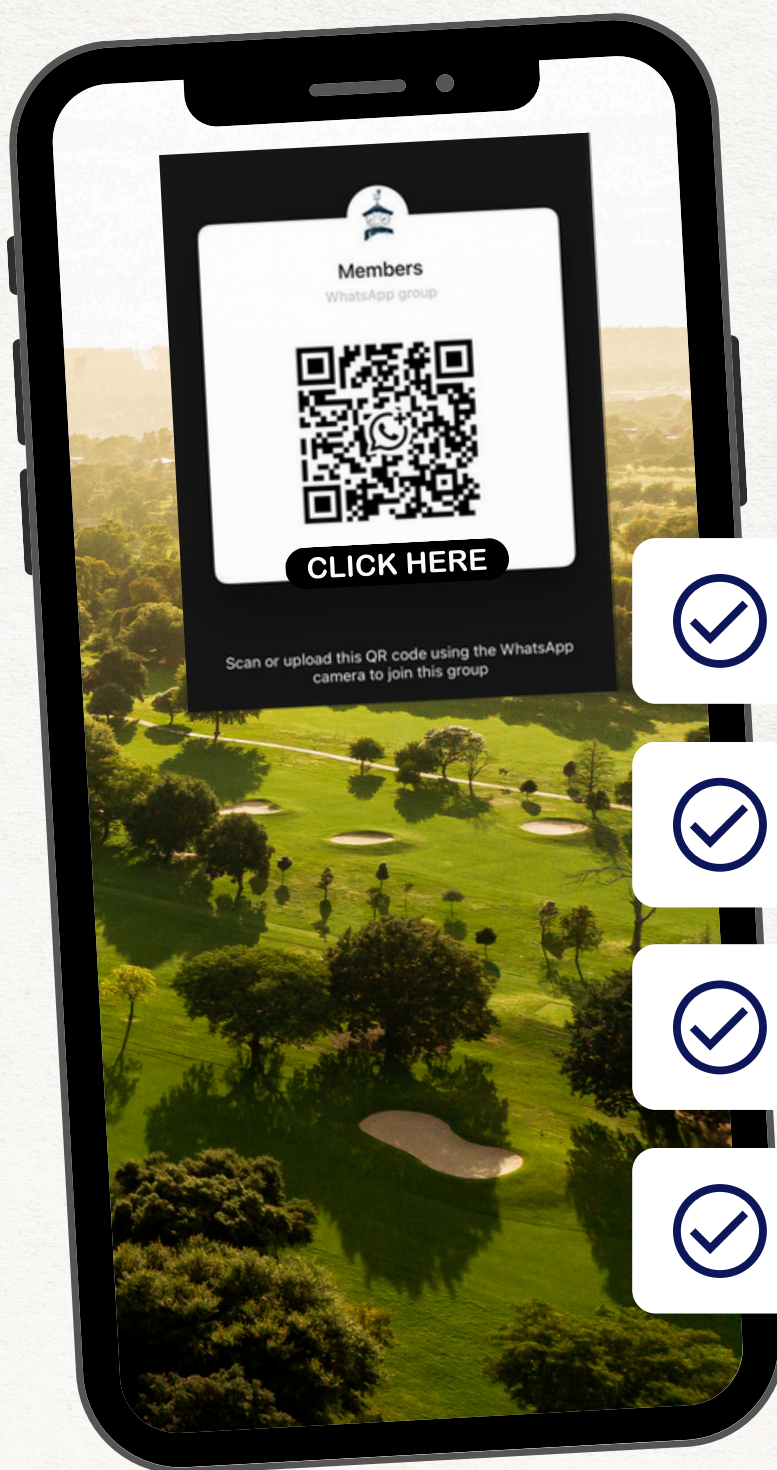

AIM POINT

Well done to AimPointer and Royal JHB member, Kian Rose!

He fell short of a win on his Betway Big Easy Tour debut at Reading Country Club a few weeks ago but the 23-year-old redeemed himself with a commanding five-stroke win in the Betway Big Easy Blu Label Invitational.

An opening round of five-under-par 66 set him for a place among the contenders, giving him another shot at a win at the place where he came so close just a month ago. He was not going to let it go this time. He rose to the occasion with a sparkling eight-under-par 63 to take his total to 13-under.

“After the round, I got asked how I feel about it,” Rose said of his scintillating final round. “I didn’t have an answer because it was sort of like a blackout. But after the round I gathered my thoughts and looked back at the round and the stats, and I realised I had 21 putts for the round. The flat stick got hot. The two holes that I got out of position off the tee, I ended up birdieing and eagling, so everything sort of aligned to what I wanted and I played just about as good as I could have.” SA Tour Golf, Oct 1, 2025

(At the recent 8 ball commando held at Royal JHB Festival of Golf, Kian ended with a round of 60, his lowest score ever, just amazing).

The recent Ryder Cup show cased so many AimPointers, both in the Europe and USA teams. One of the most exciting Ryder Cups to watch ever. Till the last putt dropped!



AimPointer Tommy Fleetwood recently won the DP World India Championship at the Delhi Golf Club, after FedExCup and Ryder Cup success.

He played a key role in Team Europe's historic Ryder Cup victory at Bethpage Black, top scoring with four points and winning each of his first four matches during a famous title defence on American soil.

The 34-year-old is inside the world's top five after two wins in a little over two months, following on from a consistent PGA Tour season, with his latest trophy his eighth DP World Tour title and first since January 2024.



Across in Asia, Pavit Tangkamolprasert served up another birdie feast on day 2, making four birdies in a row enroute to taking the halfway lead, a day after making six on the trot. A second-round five-under-par 65 to add to his opening 64, and an incredible 13 birdies over two days saw him reach 11-under. Go AimPoint!

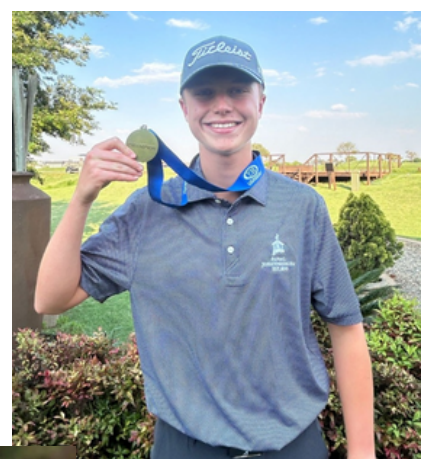
